Under the direction of the Team Leader this position will be responsible for the safe and timely execution of a variety of plant procedures. This position will be held accountable for being self-motivated while producing high quality products at an efficient rate in cooperation with co-workers.

- Positions parts according to the work order, prints and knowledge of the unit being assembled.
- Fastens parts together with bolts, screws, clips, rivets or other fasteners.
- Operates hand drills, tool and rivet machines to assist in assembly operations.
- Records all labor and downtime, documenting all information pertaining to each work order and routing.
- Helps maintain all company safety regulations to provide a clean, accident free and healthy work environment.
- Assures that the fit, function and cosmetics are at, or exceeds Roger's quality expectations.
- Confers with the team or crew leaders on any problems regarding safety, quality, production or inventory issues.

QUALIFICATION REQUIREMENTS:

- High School Education or equivalent certification.

LANGUAGE SKILL: Ability to read, analyze, and interpret the English language. Strong communication and problem-solving skills.

MATHEMATICAL SKILLS: Must possess good math skills.

REASONING ABILITY: Ability to solve practical problems and deal with the variety of situations which occur in the daily fabrication process.

PHYSICAL DEMANDS: While performing the duties of this job, the associate is regularly required to stand, use hands, and reach with hands and arms.
